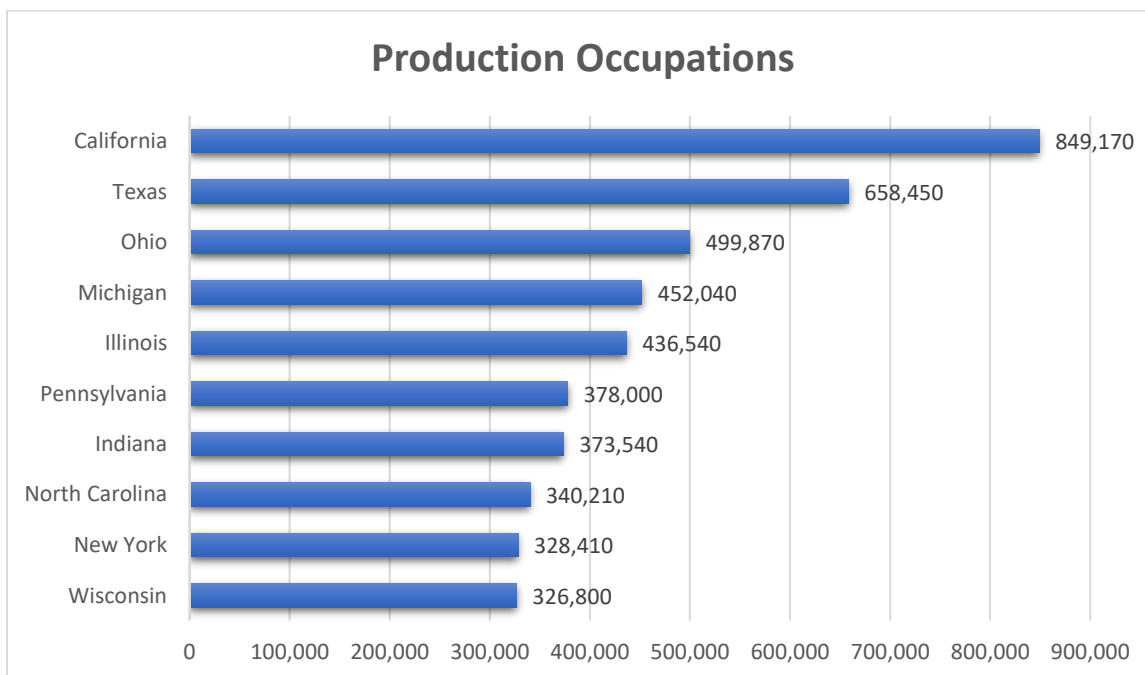
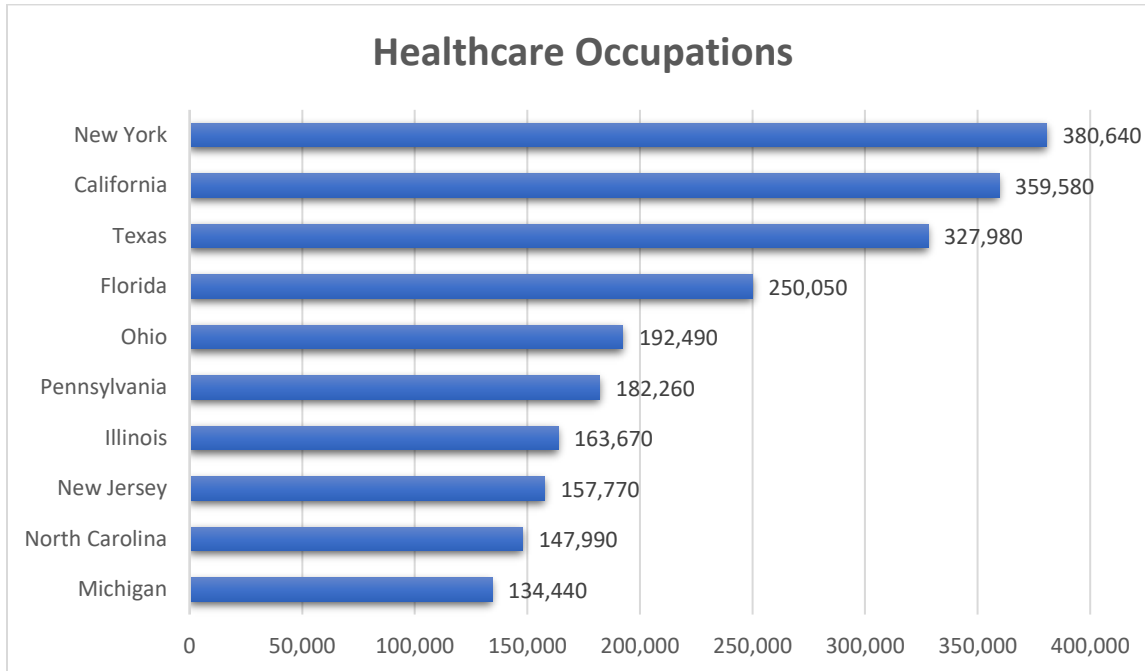
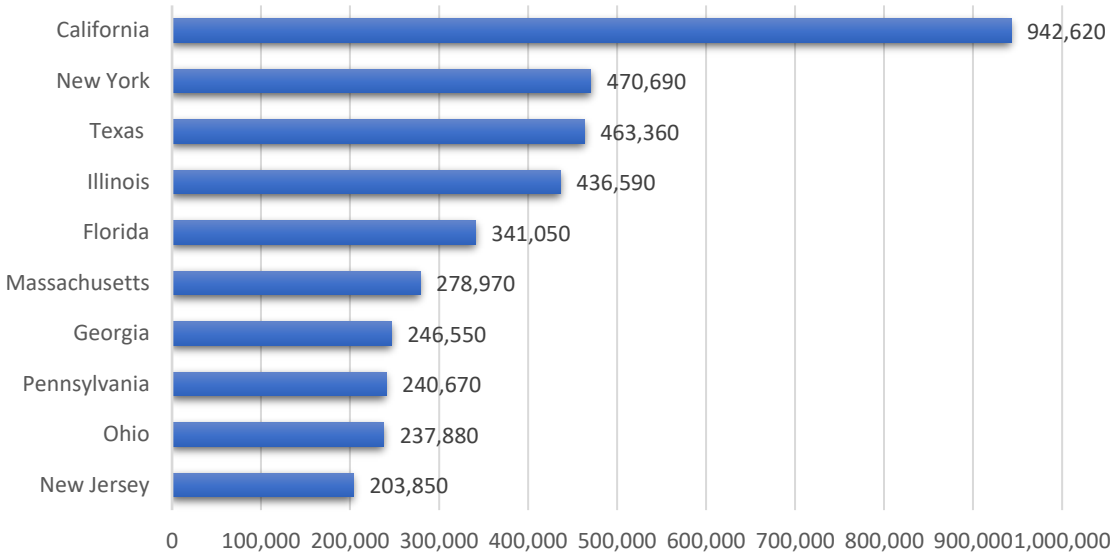


Industry Occupations and States

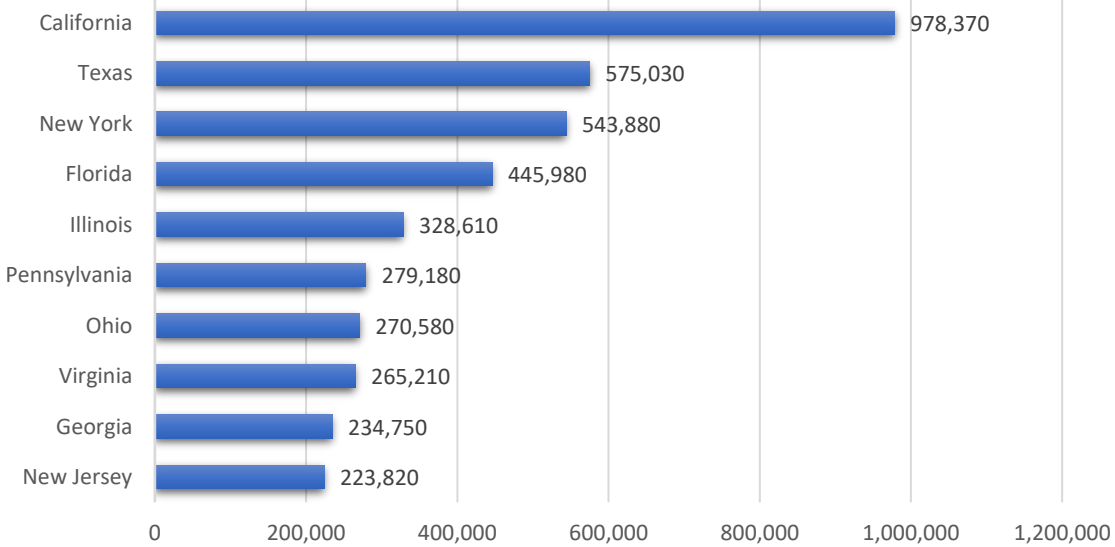

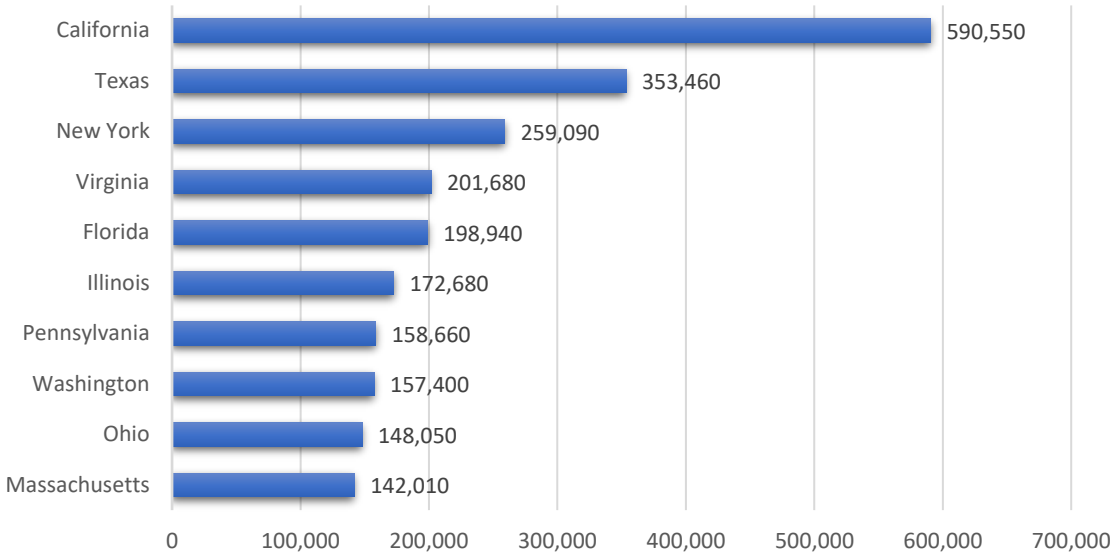
Management Occupations



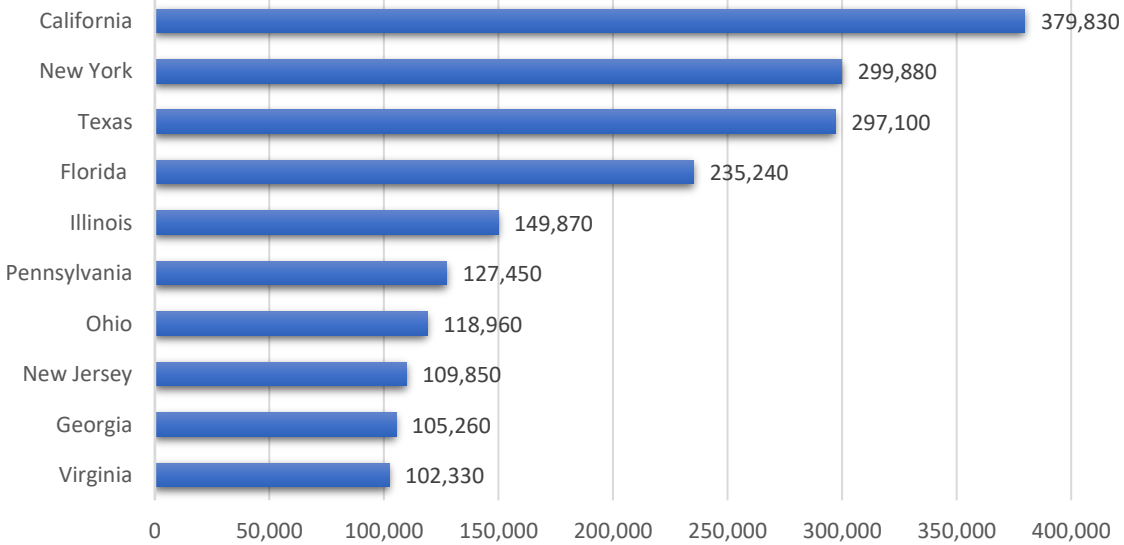
Business and Financial Operations Occupations
