

## Charitable Trust awards grants to help small non-profits in Illinois

- Funds for Charitable Trust come from the State filing fees for non-profits
- Preferences for organizations with operating budgets of up to \$1 million
- Grants of up to \$25,000 will be awarded

## **How are Grants Awarded?**

Eligible non-profits can **submit an application** through the State Treasurer's Website



2020 Applications will be accepted from January 2nd to March 31st, and from July 1st to September 30th



**Committee meets** to review applications and make final recommendations to the Treasurer

## The Charitable Trust Committee

An 11 member committee oversees the management of the fund and makes grant recommendations to the State Treasurer. The committee is made up of representatives from:

- State Treasurer's Office (Co-Chair)
- Attorney General's Office (Co-Chair)
- Lieutenant Governor's Office
- Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
- Department of Financial and Professional Regulation
- Six Private Citizens Appointed by the State Treasurer

In 2020, Charitable Trust will focus grant-making in three categories:

- Food Programs
- Housing
- Economic & Workforce Development
