Job Title: Communications Specialist

Overview: Assists Chief Communications Officer and Deputy Chief Communications Officer/Press Secretary with media inquiries and outreach opportunities. Uses various media relations techniques to convey critical messages to the public. The individual in this position performs the following duties: advancing the programs and services of the office through current and emerging communication tools, preparing and distributing written materials including press releases, speeches and promotional materials, helping to organize press events, managing clips and media lists, and creating videos for use on websites and social media to inform the public. Attendance is an essential function of this position.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work with the media to raise awareness of Treasurer's Office programs.
- Writes and distributes press releases pertaining to the activities of the Treasurer's Office as well as programs and services offered by the office.
- Writes bullet points for speeches and remarks and provides background research in preparing the Treasurer for appearances and presentations.
- Pitch photography and videography ideas to communications management team to help visually tell the story of the Treasurer's Office.
- Write scripts and shot lists to develop successful sequence of photography/videography segments.

- Proven experience in promotions, video editing, photography and videography.
- Expert knowledge in video editing and familiarity with special effects using Adobe Premier, Final Cut Pro, or similar professional video editing software.
