Overview: This position is responsible for providing multi-faceted organizational, administrative, research and communication support under the supervision of the Director to advance the awareness and success of the Invest in Illinois and Finally Home impact investment programs. The Manager will assist the Director with program implementation and day-to-day operations and collaborate with the Director and other staff of the Treasurer's Office to foster program growth and sustainability, as well as maintaining high quality governance, due-diligence and reporting processes.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assists with the design, collection and analysis of economic development activities and metrics for Invest in Illinois programs;
- Assists with all responsibilities related to the Cream of the Crop photo contest.
